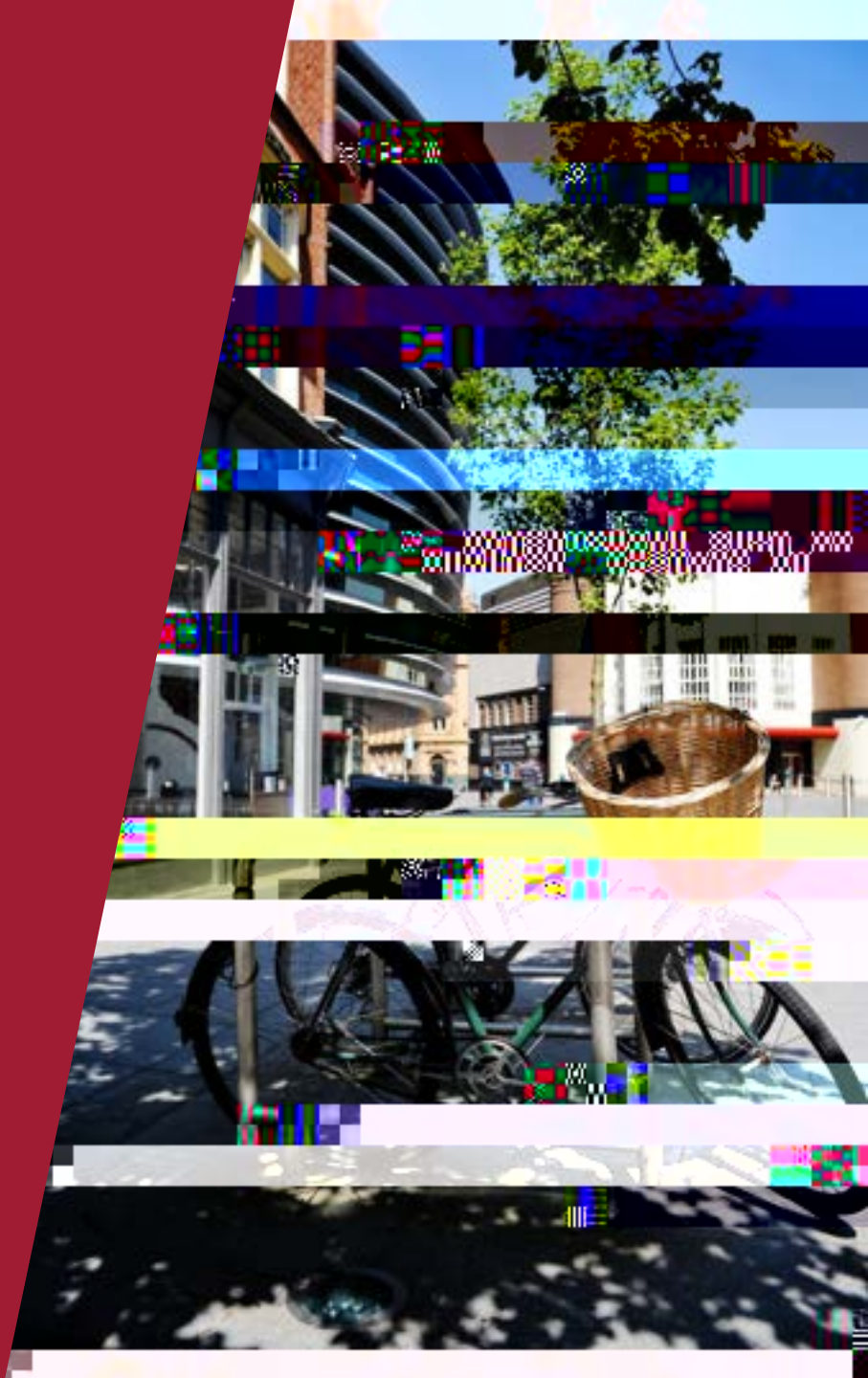

Successful bids will...

- Specify a clear project purpose and target audience.
- clearly outline how DMU students, staff and alumni can *with The Empowering University strategy.*
- Demonstrate how the project will *with the subject line CCF 24-25.* funding period.







Funding will only be paid into the bank account of a registered charity or non-profit organisation. Please note that we cannot award funding to private individuals. All applications will be considered on a case-by-case basis within each funding round and the amount of money awarded in each case is at the discretion of the panel.

Applications will be accepted from organisations and groups across Leicester and Leicestershire, and all projects must benefit the local community. Small, grassroots

be prioritised over larger organisations.

We aim to review all applications in between 4 and 6 weeks from the closing date. All decisions will be based upon the criteria specified in the information submitted in the proposal form.
